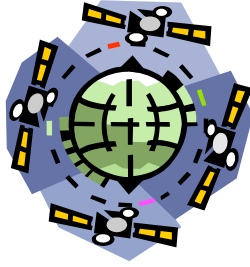


Understanding Global Positioning System (GPS)

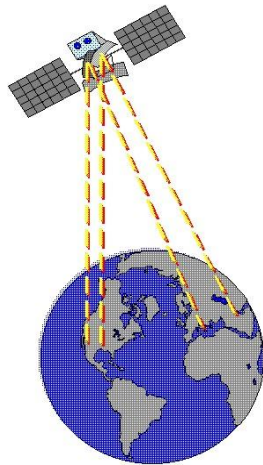
